



Safe learning environment

The safety, health and development of students must always be guaranteed during the work placement. But every workplace has risks. How do you ensure your company offers a safe learning and working environment?



A safe and healthy workplace is the basis for a successful work placement.



A physically safe environment is essential for students. They are still developing and often have less experience in assessing risks. A safe environment prevents accidents and helps students learn and work with confidence. This way, you build a valuable and safe work placement period together.

What works

- Set clear safety protocols and maintain supervision.
- Report unsafe situations.
- Give clear instructions on how to use safety gear and machines.
- Discuss risks and possible consequences of actions.
- Set a good example yourself.

What doesn't work

- Trusting that everything will go well without checking. Young people sometimes do not see dangers.
- Giving protective equipment without explaining how to use it and what the risks are.
- Not giving instructions and letting the student figure it out alone.
